

**MINUTES OF THE CITY COUNCIL

ADJOURNED REGULAR MEETING – February 3, 2014

1. CALL TO ORDER

The City Council met in Adjourned Regular Session at 6:02 p.m., Monday, February 3, 2014, in the Council Chamber, 3191 Katella Avenue, Mayor Graham-Mejia presiding.

3. ORAL COMMUNICATIONS

Mayor Graham-Mejia opened Oral Communications.

Art DeBolt, resident, spoke in opposition to the accuracy of the information provided. He urged Council not to rush the process and stated concern for going from a four year program to an eight year program.

- A. Final Draft Housing Element 2014-2021 (Community Development)**
Consideration of General Plan Amendment No. 14-01 updating the City Housing Element and associated Mitigated Negative Declaration for the Reporting Period of 2014-2021.

Assistant City Attorney Kranitz summarized the Staff report, referring to the information contained therein, and answered questions from the City Council. She read aloud the proposed changes to Resolution 2014-02.

Mayor Graham-Mejia opened the Public Hearing. There being no one present wishing to speak, Mayor Graham-Mejia closed the Public Hearing.

Council Member Grose asked for clarification that the entire process had been vetted through the Planning Commission and received approval before coming to Council.

Assistant City Attorney Kranitz stated yes, with the exception of the Cypress letter that was received after the Planning Commission had taken its action.

Mayor Graham-Mejia stated the document was very informative. She indicated at a previous workshop she had some issues of concern and for consistency, she would not be supporting this item.


Motion/Second: Grose/Murphy


6. ADJOURNMENT
