Subject: Approval of Plans and Specifications, and Authorization to Bid for Old Dutch Haven Neighborhood Streets and Catalina Truck/Fork Lift Crossing Rehabilitation Project (CIP No. 14/15-02)

Summary: This report recommends actions to begin facilitating the construction of the Old Dutch Haven Neighborhood Streets and Catalina Truck/Fork Lift Crossing Rehabilitation Project (CIP No. 14/15-02).

Recommendation:

1. Approve the plans and specifications for the construction of the Old Dutch Haven Neighborhood Streets and Catalina Truck/Fork Lift Crossing Rehabilitation Project (CIP No. 14/15-02); and,
2. Authorize Staff to advertise and solicit bid proposals.

Background

The City of Los Alamitos proposes to grind and overlay Thor Avenue and Cherry Street while slurry sealing Pine Street, Reagan Street and Snark Avenue in the Old Dutch Haven Neighborhood per the City's 2013 approved Pavement Management Plan. On Catalina Street east of Cherry Street, a section of asphalt will be removed and be replaced with concrete at the truck/fork lift crossing adjacent to Trend Offset Printing.

The overlay streets within the project limits will be ground and resurfaced with 1.75-inch thick Asphalt Rubber Hot Mix (ARHM), or removed and replaced with Asphalt Concrete (AC) over Aggregate Base (AB). The slurry seal proportions shall be done in accordance with the Standard Specifications. Visible cracks will be filled with rubberized crack filling material. All manhole, water valve, anode and monitoring well covers within the project limits will be adjusted to grade. Existing curbs and driveways will be

protected in place within the limits of the project. This project will also reinstall traffic striping, pavement markers, signing and install loop detectors at signalized intersections

Discussion

Following is an approximate timeline for the completion of the Old Dutch Haven Neighborhood Streets and Catalina Truck/Fork Lift Crossing Rehabilitation Project:

- 2/18/15 Approval of plans & specifications by the City Council
- 2/26/15 Advertise project
- 3/19/15 Bid opening
- 4/20/15 Award of Contract
- 5/4/15 Start of construction
- 6/26/15 End of construction

Awarding of Contract will occur at a future City Council Meeting.

Fiscal Impact


The construction estimate for the project is \$257,000. The 2014/2015 adopted CIP budget includes \$322,200 for design, construction management and construction of these projects. Funding sources are Gas Tax (\$50,000), Traffic Improvement (\$45,000) and Measure M (\$227,200). The breakout per project is below:

- Old Dutch Haven - \$292,200
- Catalina Truck Crossing Rehabilitation - \$30,000
