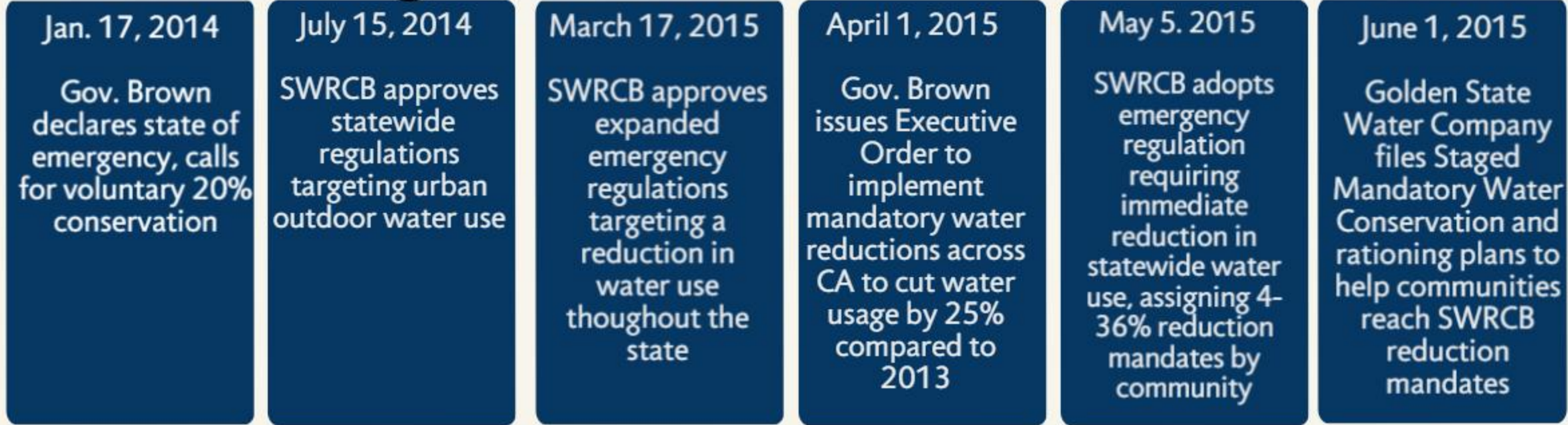


Orange County District Staged Mandatory Water Conservation & Rationing Overview

Local Restrictions: What YOU need to do

Watering Days

In YOUR Community

Wednesday/Sunday

Addresses ending in **EVEN** numbers

Tuesday/Saturday

Addresses ending in **ODD** numbers



Current Stage

Stage 1

Stage 1 is currently in place for Orange County District customers.

Mandatory Reduction Stages



Outdoor irrigation limited to two days per week, before 8 am or after 7 pm; watering days listed above

Stage 1



Irrigation restrictions from Stage 1; \$2.50 emergency surcharge per CcF over allocation

Stage 2



Irrigation restrictions from Stage 1; \$5 emergency surcharge per CcF over allocation

Stage 3



Irrigation restrictions from Stage 1; \$10 emergency surcharge per CcF over allocation

State Restrictions: What EVERYONE needs to do

- Avoid watering outdoor landscapes in a way that causes water to "runoff" onto adjacent property, non-irrigated areas, private and public walkways, roadways, parking lots, or structures.
- Avoid washing a vehicle, with a hose without a shut-off nozzle or other device that will immediately stop the flow of water when not in use.

- Avoid using drinking water to wash driveways and sidewalks.
- Avoid using drinking water in a fountain or other decorative water feature, except where the water is recirculated.
- Customers are not allowed to irrigate turf or ornamental landscapes during and 48 hours following measurable precipitation.

- Restaurants and other food service establishments can only serve water to customers on request
- Hotels and motels must provide guests with the option of not having towels and linens laundered daily
