Motion/Second: Murphy/Hasselbrink


Unanimously Carried: The City Council appointed Larry Andrade with a term expiring December 2017, and John Riley with a term expiring December 2018, to the Planning Commission.

Mayor Murphy advised Commissioner-Elect Andrade would begin service at the September meeting.


Council Member Hasselbrink requested the meeting be adjourned in memory of Brian Collette who passed away at the age of 42 from cancer.
