Subject: Resolution No. 2015-36 Solidifying Support for the Orange County Transit Authority (OCTA) Grant for Los Alamitos Boulevard Beautification Project

Summary: The City applied for grant funding through Orange County Transit Authority's (OCTA) 2016 Comprehensive Transportation Funding Program on October 23, 2015 for Los Alamitos Boulevard. OCTA is now requesting a resolution solidifying the Council's support for the Grant Application.

Recommendation: Adopt Resolution No. 2015-36, entitled, "A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOS ALAMITOS, CALIFORNIA FOR CANDIDATE ORANGE COUNTY COMPREHENSIVE TRANSPORTATION PROGRAMS PROJECTS".

Background

The City of Los Alamitos Capital Improvement Program for this year (2015-16) includes the Los Alamitos Boulevard Beautification Project including the design and construction of a raised center median on Los Alamitos Boulevard between Farquhar and the Coyote Creek Channel. City Staff applied for grant funding through OCTA's 2016 Comprehensive Transportation Funding Program Call for Projects on October 23, 2015 for Los Alamitos Boulevard between Katella Avenue north to Cerritos Avenue.

RESOLUTION NO. 2015-36

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOS ALAMITOS, CALIFORNIA, FOR CANDIDATE ORANGE COUNTY COMPREHENSIVE TRANSPORTATION PROGRAMS PROJECTS

WHEREAS, the City of Los Alamitos desires to implement the transportation improvements of Los Alamitos Blvd. Gap Closure improvement project; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Los Alamitos has been declared by the Orange County Transportation Authority to meet the eligibility requirements to receive M2 "Fair Share" funds; and,

WHEREAS, the City's Circulation Element is consistent with the County of Orange Master Plan of Arterial Highways; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Los Alamitos will provide a minimum of 25% in matching funds for the Los Alamitos Blvd. Gap Closure project as required by the Orange County Comprehensive Transportation Funding Programs Guidelines; and,

WHEREAS, the Orange County Transportation Authority intends to allocate funds for transportation improvement projects within the incorporated cities and the County; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Los Alamitos will not use M2 funds to supplant Developer Fees or other commitments; and,

WHEREAS, the City must include all projects funded by Net Revenues in the seven-year Capital Improvement Program as part of the Measure M2 Ordinance eligibility requirement; and,

WHEREAS, the City authorizes a formal amendment to the seven-year Capital Improvement Program to add projects approved for funding upon approval from the Orange County Transportation Authority Board of Directors.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOS ALAMITOS DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Requests the Orange County Transportation Authority allocate funds in the amounts specified in the City's application to said County from the Comprehensive Transportation Programs. Said funds shall be matched by funds from said City as required and shall be used as supplemental funding to aid the City in the improvement of the following street(s): Los Alamitos Boulevard.

SECTION 2. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption by the City Council, and the City Clerk shall certify the vote adopting this resolution.
