Alley Construction Coming Your Way

Starting September 6, 2016 the City will reconstruct the alley between Farquhar and Howard; from Reagan to Maple Street.

How Long?

The project will take approximately 3 weeks (September 6 – 26) wherein a contractor will remove the asphalt and replace it with concrete. All dates are estimates and subject to change as construction can take longer or shorter than expected due to various unforeseen conditions.

Can I Use the Alley?

Portions of the Alley will be closed during construction (See attached maps for details). Parking in the garages and drive areas will be inaccessible during closures.


Where do I Park?

Parking will be on the streets surrounding the neighborhood, with street sweeping and parking regulations canceled during construction. Temporary ADA accessible parking will be made available in certain areas as well as parking for the less abled.

Where does my trash go?

The trash hauler will place the large metal dumpsters in front of the residences. It will be the responsibility of residents to place the small rolling carts out each week on the street for trash pickup.

The City's goal is to create as little disruption as possible; however, there will be times when the project will present a parking inconvenience. 
