### **LARGE CROWD EXPECTED FOR SUNDAY'S WINGS, WHEELS & ROTORS EXPO ARRIVE EARLY, BE PATIENT AND FOLLOW LAW ENFORCEMENT INSTRUCTIONS**

LOS ALAMITOS, Calif. – This Sunday's 15<sup>th</sup> annual Wings, Wheels and Rotors Expo (WWRE), presented by the Los Alamitos Chamber of Commerce, is expected to attract more than 20,000 spectators and impact traffic moving in-and-out of Joint Forces Training Base (JFTB) and surrounding streets.
