

The Orange County Transportation Authority (OCTA) would like to request your assistance in helping us communicate with stakeholders in your community. The OCTA Board of Directors is seeking qualified applicants for a Public Member seat on the OCTA Board of Directors (Board). The 18-member Board is comprised of all five county supervisors, ten elected city council members, two members of the public and a non-voting member representing Caltrans. Public Members are selected by the Board. The incumbent of this position is eligible to seek re-selection to another term.

Candidates for this seat must be residents of Orange County and have a familiarity with transportation issues, finance, OCTA priorities in addition to having an interest in serving the public. A person who is currently serving as an elected official within Orange County (any local jurisdiction or special district) or who has held any such position in the past four years, is not eligible to apply.

Board Members are responsible for attending public Board meetings on the second and fourth Monday of every month (excluding holidays), and various committee meetings. Special meetings, events and workshops. The monthly anticipated time commitment is between 15 to 20 hours per month, the majority of them during business hours.
