Background

The Los Alamitos Municipal Code provides for the appointment of residents to City Boards and Commissions. City Council policy has determined interested parties, including incumbents, need to submit an application for consideration by the Council. All applicants are interviewed before the Council in an open setting.

Vacancies have occurred on the Parks, Recreation, and Cultural Arts, Personnel Appeals, and Traffic Commission. Availability Notices were posted at City facilities, on the City's website and Facebook site, aired on Los Al TV and copies were provided to the press inviting residents to apply for these positions.

Discussion

In October 2016, Staff began recruiting for the upcoming vacancies. The deadline to apply was November 7, 2016.

Parks, Recreation, and Cultural Arts Commission (PRCA) – 3 scheduled vacancies

Commissioners Michael Bell, Julie Decker, and Alice Jempsa have terms that will expire December 2016. Incumbents Michael Bell and Julie Decker are not seeking reappointment. Incumbent Alice Jempsa has reapplied for the position. Incumbents would continue to serve through December. New appointees would begin service in January 2017, with a three year term ending December 2019. Five applications were received.

Betty Schmicker-Black moved out of the City and accordingly submitted her resignation. Commissioner Chuck Landon's term will expire December 2016 and he has reapplied to the Commission. Incumbents would continue to serve through December. New appointees would begin service in January 2017. One appointee would fill an unexpired term ending December 2018. One appointee would fill a full four year term ending December 2020. Three applications were received.

Thomas Lindsay resigned from the Traffic Commission. Commissioner James Wilhelm's term expired May 2016. Commissioners Gina Biri, Javier Mejia, and Daniel Patz have terms that will expire in December. Incumbent Biri and Wilhelm are not seeking reappointment. Incumbent Mejia has reapplied for the position. One appointee would begin service immediately, relieving Incumbent Wilhelm of his duties. Incumbents Biri, Mejia, and Patz would continue to serve through December. New appointees would begin service in January 2017. One appointee would fill an unexpired term ending December 2017. Four appointees would fill a full three year term expiring December 2019. Five applications were received.


