



Background

The Los Alamitos Municipal Code provides for the appointment of residents to City Boards and Commissions. City Council policy has determined interested parties, including incumbents, need to submit an application for consideration by the Council. All applicants are interviewed before the Council in an open setting.

Three scheduled vacancies on the Planning Commission and two unscheduled vacancies on the Traffic Commission have occurred. Availability Notices were posted at City Facilities, on the City's Website, through Channel-3, and copies were provided to the press inviting residents to apply for these positions.

Discussion

At the end of December, three Commissioners' terms expired on the Planning Commission (Larry Andrade, Wendy Grose, and Gary Loe). Six applications were received for 3 vacancies, all incumbents have reapplied.

In addition, the Traffic Commission has two unexpired terms set to expire in May 2013. Ms. Pauline Bloom passed away. Richard Murphy was elected to City Council in November and subsequently took office in December. Accordingly, he submitted his resignation to the Traffic Commission. One application has been received for the two unscheduled vacancies. Staff is recommending postponing further recruitment until April 2013. At that time, two additional vacancies will have expired and a scheduled recruitment could be held.


In order to streamline recruitment process, Staff is recommending that moving forward all terms expire in December. Currently, the Local Appointments list has expiration dates throughout the year. Staff time and Commission confusion would be lessened if all terms expired during the same month. The term years would still remain staggered to avoid a lack of quorum on any one Commission. Once fully implemented, Commission recruitment and interviews would take place in November/December of every year and this would help to ensure each Commission started with full membership in the new year. Please note, should an unexpected vacancy occur, a special recruitment would take place to fill the vacancy as soon as possible.

At this time, it is appropriate to conduct applicant interviews so appointments may be considered.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City of Los Alamitos encourages residents to apply for positions on City Commissions, Boards and Committees that will have vacancies in 2011. At the end of each year, the City releases a list of expiring appointed terms for the coming year, names of incumbents, and the dates of their appointments. The following is a complete list for 2011. QUALIFICATIONS AND REQUIREMENTS: Members of the following Commissions and Boards shall be appointed, and shall be subject to removal, by motion of the City Council adopted by a majority vote. The members thereof shall be appointed from the qualified electors of the City, none of who shall hold any paid office or employment in the City government and shall serve until their respective successors are appointed and qualified. If a member of a Board or Commission is absent from three (3) consecutive meetings of such Board or Commission, unless by permission of such Board or Commission expressed in its official minutes, or is convicted of a crime involving moral turpitude, or ceases to be a qualified elector of the City, his/her office shall become vacant and shall be so declared by the City Council.

Planning Commissioners are designated "code filers" under California Government Code Section 87200. All other Boards/Commissions are designated "code filers" under the City's Conflict of Interest Code (COIC). Financial disclosure must be made periodically on specific forms and become documents of public record.

CABLE TELEVISION COMMISSION - The Cable Commission consists of five members, plus one-full time student member who is at least 16 years of age. The Commission meets on the third Wednesday of January, March, May, July, September & November, at 7:00 p.m., in the Los Alamitos Council Chambers, 3191 Katella Avenue, Los Alamitos. The Cable Commission is responsible for the administration of the local cable television access program. Applicants must be interviewed by the City Council prior to appointment.
