




City Council Redistricting

The City of Los Alamitos is asking for your help to plan and redraw new City district lines. In 2018, the City of Los Alamitos created City Council Districts. Every 10 years, local governments use new data from the Census to redraw their district lines to reflect how local populations have change. The City must redraw the district lines based on the new 2020 Census data.
