Subject: Approval of Plans and Specifications and Authorization to Bid for Alley Improvement Project (CIP No. 15/16-02)

Summary: This report recommends actions to begin facilitating the construction of the alley from Reagan Street to Maple Street, between Howard Avenue and Farquhar Avenue.

Recommendation:

1. Approve the plans and specifications for the construction of the Alley Improvement Project (CIP No. 15/16-02); and,
2. Authorize Staff to advertise and solicit bid proposals.

Background

The City of Los Alamitos proposes to reconstruct the alley from Reagan Street to Maple Street, between Howard Avenue and Farquhar Avenue.

The asphalt alley will be removed and replaced with Portland Cement Concrete (PCC) pavement and aggregate base over compacted native material. All manhole, water valve, anode and monitoring well covers within the project limits will be adjusted to grade. Existing curbs, fence, block wall and private facilities will be protected in place within the limits of the project unless otherwise shown.


Following is an approximate timeline for the completion of the Alley Improvement Project:

- 9/21/15 Approval of plans & specifications by the City Council
- 9/28/15 Advertise project
- 10/12/15 Bid opening
- 10/19/15 Award of Contract
- 10/26/15 Start of construction
- 11/25/15 End of construction

Fiscal Impact


The construction estimate for the project is \$146,000 and the funding for this project is from two different 2015/2016 adopted budgets. Funding sources are from the CDBG program (\$135,000) and Measure M (\$11,000). The budgeted numbers include construction and construction management.
