**SUBJECT: COUNCIL MEMBER JOSH WILSON RESIGNS DUE TO RELOCATING  
OUT-OF-STATE**

Council Member Josh Wilson has announced that he will resign from the Los Alamitos City Council effective Monday, November 13, 2017.

In addition to City Council, Wilson has served the community as Chairman of the Los Alamitos Area Chamber of Commerce, Chairman of the Los Alamitos Parks, Recreation & Cultural Arts Commission and as a board member of the Casa Youth Shelter. Wilson will be leaving his position at Southland Credit Union, based in Los Alamitos, for an executive position with Whitefish Credit Union in Whitefish, Montana – the state’s largest credit union.

“Reaching the decision to leave Los Alamitos was difficult,” said Wilson. “I am sincerely appreciative of the community’s support and I am proud of my service to the city. I have the utmost confidence that Los Alamitos will continue to thrive under the leadership of the City Council and the dedication of the city staff.”

Per Los Alamitos city charter, the city council has sixty days from the date of resignation to consider holding a special election or appointing a council member to fill the vacancy. The item is scheduled to be discussed at the Los Alamitos City Council meeting on Monday, November 20, 2017.
