3. SPECIAL ORDERS OF THE DAY

A. City Council and Traffic Commission Workshop

At its April 15, 2019 Council meeting, representatives from the Traffic Commission requested and Council concurred a joint meeting with City Council and Traffic Commission would be beneficial to increase communication and ensure consistency. This workshop will allow the City Council and Traffic Commission to discuss items of interest. The goal is to allow the City Council to provide concise direction to the Traffic Commission and to allow the Traffic Commission to seek clarification on policy direction. Based on discussion, Staff may be directed to prepare future agenda items for formal action. Discussion tonight shall be limited to subject matter jurisdiction of the City Council and/or Traffic Commission.

City Manager Plumlee and Development Services Director Johnson introduced the item.

City Council and Traffic Commission discussed the role of the Commission, ways to improve communication between the Council and Commission, and the permit parking program and public outreach involved. Council requested exploring televising the Traffic Commission meetings. Consensus was received to provide a summary memo of what was discussed and decisions made to the Council after all Traffic Commission meetings.

Staff suggested keeping the permit parking program as is and begin enforcement. After implementation the program could be reevaluated to see if a need still existed for permit parking. Council stressed the importance of informing the community of the permit program before any enforcement begins.


4. ADJOURNMENT
