The intent of this Addendum No. 2 is to provide answers to questions.

I. The following answers to questions received shall be acknowledged:

Q1. What is the engineer's estimate?

A1. The engineer's opinion of cost for Schedule A is between \$93,000 and \$103,000.

Q2. Are encroachment permits required?

A2. A no-fee permit will be issued.

II. The attached Pre-Bid Information Sheet shall be acknowledged.

III. The Special Provisions shall be used in submitting bids, and an acknowledgment of receipt of this Addendum No. 2 shall be entered on Page 6 of the Bid Proposal. Failure to provide such acknowledgment shall render the bid as non-responsive and subject to rejection.

PRE-BID INFORMATION SHEET

Project: CDBG Howard Avenue Street Improvements, City of Los Alamitos

Prevailing Wage Requirements: Workers must be listed on the payrolls with the Federal wage classification that applies to the work performed. Higher State rates for comparable classifications must be paid. The applicable federal wage decision is the decision in effect ten (10) calendar days prior to bid opening (currently CA20210024, Modification 3, dated February 12, 2021). The state wage determination is ORA-2020-2; it is available online at <https://www.dir.ca.gov/OPRL/DPreWageDetermination.htm>. Pre-determined increases in state rates are available and will apply to this project.

Apprentice Requirements: Apprentices must be registered with the U.S. Department of Labor (DOL) and a copy of the certification provided with the first payroll on which the apprentice appears. State apprentice requirements also apply, including DAS-140, DAS-142, and payment of CAC training funds.

Subcontracting: All subcontracts shall include the applicable federal prevailing wage decision and the Federal Labor Standards Provisions (Form HUD-4010), which is in the specifications. A List of Proposed Subcontractors must be submitted with the bid.

Eligibility: Contractors and all subcontractors shall be registered with the California State License Board (CSLB) and with the California Department of Industrial Relations (DIR) at the time of bid; they must also have current workers' compensation insurance coverage and not appear on state or federal debarment lists. Contract award will be reported to the U.S. Department of Labor.
