City Clerk Quintanar summarized the Staff report and answered questions from the City Council.

City Council discussed the following topics:

- This was a fluid process done every 10 years at the State level
- This process would not change the City of Los Alamitos boundaries
- Support for staying in Districts with orange County cities of similar size
- Importance of having Orange County representation, especially in regards to shared services of orange County Fire Authority, Sanitation district, and orange County Transportation Authority
- Concern a Los Angeles County representative would not be well apprised of the concerns of Los Alamitos

- This process would not change the School District
