Temporary Runway 12-30 Closure | March 29 - July 18, 2023

- Runway 12-30 will be CLOSED NIGHTLY, Sundays through Thursdays, from March 29 - July 18
- In addition, Runway 12-30 will be CLOSED DAILY, Tuesdays and Wednesdays, from April 18 - May 24
- Persons living near the airport may see a temporary change in aircraft activity.
- Flight paths and aircraft altitude are under the jurisdiction of the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA)

The Rossmoor/Los Alamitos Area Sewer District will be performing maintenance work on existing sewer systems throughout the City of Los Alamitos. The work will consist of pipe cleaning and manhole repairs. Work is scheduled from June through October 2023. Access to driveways and roadways will remain open during the work. Traffic control will be staged at specific locations as needed. It is not anticipated that sewer service to homes and businesses will be impacted from the work, however, if there may, Los Alamitos residents will be notified prior to a shut off.




