





Key Features of the Streamlining Solar Photovoltaic (PV) Permit

The qualified rooftop solar project can expect:

- New simplified Solar Permit Application – just one application to complete!
- Apply for the qualifying Expedited Solar PV Permit through our Los Alamitos Permit Center at <https://losalamitos.cts.city/> or in person at City Hall.
- Residential Photovoltaic Eligibility Checklist – for projects that comply with the new screening checklist, no structural plan check required!
- Photovoltaic panel and associated

Campers, Trailers, and Recreational Vehicles unless otherwise permitted, must be stored off of the street for vehicle storage

Remember that your Camper, Trailer, or Recreational Vehicle, unless otherwise prohibited, must be stored off the street in an area designated on your property for vehicle storage as it is restricted by zoning requirements. They may be temporarily stored on the street in front of your residence, for no more than a 24-hour period with the issuance of an overnight parking pass issued by the Los Alamitos Police Department. Parking on the street is limited to loading and unloading of equipment and supplies. So don't forget to add that overnight parking pass to your packing list before you leave!
