

You may be eligible for a one-time* **GRANT AWARD \$2,500**

*If you have already applied for this grant award and/or received the California Small Business COVID-19 Relief Grant, please do not apply.

WHAT IS A QUALIFIED MICROBUSINESS?

- Was in business prior to December 31, 2019
- Is currently active and operating
- Is the owners primary means of income
- Had less than \$50,000 in gross revenue in 2019
- Has less than 5 full time employees
- Did not receive the California Small Business COVID-19 Relief Grant

Small businesses owned by women, veterans, minorities, independent contractors, individuals without documentation, and individuals with limited English proficiency are encouraged to apply.


