COMMON CODE VIOLATIONS

1

Overflowing trash containers or dumpsters; visible bulky items or junk left in the front, side or rear yards for an extended period of time

2

Overgrown vegetation and neglected maintenance such as walls, fences that are deteriorated, faded or chipped paint, broken parts or holes

3

Illegal use of temporary signs on public right of ways consisting of garage/yard sale signs, real estate, general advertisement

The application provides a web-based portal that streamlines and automates solar permit reviews, making it possible to obtain a residential solar permit expeditiously. The official flower of the City
of Los Alamitos is a Daisy

In 1981, the Los Alamitos City Council discovered Los Alamitos was one of the few cities that did not have a city flower. Council assigned the task of choosing the official flower to the City's Fine Arts & Cultural Affairs Commission. The entire community was involved in conducting a city-wide contest soliciting recommendations. Those eligible to enter the contest were students attending the Los Alamitos Unified School District. The winning submittal, Stan Weed, an elementary school student, recommended the Daisy to be chosen as the official flower of the City of Los Alamitos because he felt "The Daisy would be a good flower, because it is bright and sunny, like the Los Alamitos climate". making the Daisy the official flower for the City of Los Alamitos.
