

COMMON CODE VIOLATIONS

1

Overflowing trash containers or dumpsters; visible bulky items or junk left in the front, side or rear yards for extended period of time

2

Overgrown vegetation and neglected maintenance such as walls, fences that are deteriorated, faded or chipped paint, broken parts or holes

3

Illegal use of temporary signs on public right of ways consisting of garbage/yard sale signs, real estate, general advertisement

The City of Los Alamitos announced the launch of CityTech Solutions featuring SolarAPP+, an automated permitting application including the permitting of new residential rooftop solar and storage systems. This program ensures Los Alamitos' compliance with SB 379, the Solar Access Act, which requires cities and counties to adopt automated solar permitting systems to shorten project timelines and lower permit costs for residential solar installations.

SolarAPP+ provides a web-based portal that streamlines and automates solar permit reviews, making it possible to obtain a residential solar permit expeditiously. The app easily integrates into the Los Alamitos' existing permitting software, CityTech Solutions, and is free for local jurisdictions.
