## Pole Replacement Work

SCE will be performing a pole replacement at the back of the residential property at 12122 Pine Street. The work will be day work and will take place on 4/8.

Traffic control will be implemented, and Pine Street will be closed to normal traffic from Bradbury Road to Kempton Drive to convey vehicles away from the crane that will be used to place the pole. Drivers can ask SCE crew members for assistance to their driveways as needed.


- Bulky items (i.e. furniture, appliances, bags of trash)






