

City Council Election

Candidate Filing through August 9, 2024— Starting Monday, July 15, those interested in running for the Office of Council Member in Districts 1, 2, and 3 for election in the 2024 General Municipal Election can begin the candidate filing process by contacting the Office of the City Clerk.

A candidate must be a registered voter in the district to qualify for one of the offices up for election. Eligible citizens can download many of the required candidacy documents by visiting the City's website at cityoflosalamitos.org/2024election.

The City Clerk's Office issues candidacy documents at its office, 3191 Katella Ave.,



Los Alamitos, CA 90720, Monday through Thursday from 7:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. City Offices are closed on Fridays. Candidates must file these completed forms in that office no later than Friday, August 9. Appointments are required for August 9, 2024 and are limited to the hours of 10 a.m. to 2 p.m.




