NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, at the above-referenced date and time, the Planning Commission of the City of Los Alamitos will conduct a Public Hearing to consider the following item:

Consideration of a recommendation to the Los Alamitos City Council to certify an Environmental Impact Report and to approve a Site Development Permit – Major (SDP 22-02), Tentative Parcel Map (TPM 22-01) 2022-133 (for Finance and Conveyance Purposes), Vesting Tentative Tract Map (TTM 22-01) No. 19263 (for Condominium Purposes), and an Affordable Housing Unit Application for Density Bonus and/or Incentives or Concessions to redevelop the Project site with 246 residential units. The Proposed Project would demolish an existing office building and surface parking lot on the 12.3-acre property and redevelop the Project site with 246 residential units consisting of a variety of different product types, including 55 single-family detached homes, 114 townhomes, and 77 for-rent multi-family apartment homes comprised of 76 units restricted to lower-income households and one unrestricted manager's unit, and construction of associated site improvements ("Proposed Project"). The Proposed Project site is located at 4665 Lampson Avenue, in the City of Los Alamitos, County of Orange (Assessor Parcel Number (APN) 130-012-35). Specifically, the Proposed Project site is north of Lampson Avenue and northwest of the intersection of Lampson Avenue and Rose Street (Applicant: Matt Waken – Lampson Park Place, LLC).

Environmental Determination: The Proposed Project is subject to the California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA"). An Environmental Impact Report (EIR) (SCH No. 2022090476) has been prepared to analyze the Proposed Project's potential environmental impacts, to identify significant impacts, to propose mitigation measures that would minimize, reduce, or avoid significant impacts, and to analyze project alternatives. In compliance with the CEQA guidelines, the EIR was available for public review for 45 days (from April 24, 2024, to June 10, 2024). The EIR identifies significant effects related to Biological Resources, Cultural Resources, Geology and Soils, Transportation, and Tribal Cultural Resources. Mitigation measures have been incorporated to ensure that these impacts will be mitigated to less than significant, with the exception of impacts related to Transportation (Vehicle Miles Traveled), which would remain significant and unavoidable. The Project site is not located on any list of hazardous materials sites compiled pursuant to Government Code Section 65962.5.

The Planning Commission will consider a recommendation to the City Council to certify the EIR and to approve the Proposed Project. The Environmental Impact Report is available through the link below:
