### Vote Centers

Vote Centers are your one-stop shop for voting in Orange County. There are more than 180 Vote Centers (open 4 or 11 days) where you can drop off your ballot, vote in person, register to vote, get a replacement ballot, or receive in-person assistance. ## Government Accountability, Transparency Charter Reform Measure

In the November 2024 general election, registered voters will see Measure X - Los Alamitos City Government Accountability, Transparency Charter Reform on the ballot. The measure aims to update the City Charter, which was initially established in 1966.

Measure X offers several key reforms including updating the public works contracting requirements, establishing district-specific term limits for City Council members, updating language related to district elections, placing local campaign contribution limits on those seeking City Council office and requiring public filing and disclosure of lobbyist activities in the City.

### Nites on Pine St. Last One!




