- Electronic equipment (i.e. refrigerators, washer and dryers)
- Unlimited bagged yard waste and bundled tree branches (Max length of 48 inches)
- Electronic waste (i.e. TV, computer, microwave)

### FREE PAPER SHREDDING:

- A certified mobile shred truck will immediately shred documents
- Limit of 4 banker boxes per car
- Excluded items include binders, electronic media, x-rays, and plastic/trash
