


## Obtaining Parking Permits Just Got Easier!

Beginning June 1, 2025, the City of Los Alamitos is launching a new online parking permitting system:

[losalamitos.getapermit.net](https://losalamitos.getapermit.net) to improve accessibility and streamline the application process for residents and businesses. Residential parking permit renewals for the 2025–2026 cycle will also begin June 1, with enforcement starting September 1. Each household in a permit zone may request up to three free residential permits and two visitor permits, valid through June 30, 2026. Any additional permits will be subject to a fee. Proof of residency and valid vehicle registration are required. Permits for oversized vehicles, boats, trailers, RVs, and temporary waste containers will also transition to the new platform starting July 1. # Improvements are Coming to the I-605/Katella Avenue Interchange



OCTA and Caltrans are kicking off construction on the I-605/Katella Avenue Interchange Project later this month. Contractors are expected to begin mobilizing equipment as they gear up for construction to improve the local interchange as well as enhance safety and mobility along Katella Avenue between Coyote Creek Channel and Epson Way. The project is intended to benefit motorists, bicyclists and pedestrians and include these improvements:

- Modifying northbound and southbound on- and off- ramps at Katella
- Adding Class II bike lanes and ADA curb ramps along eastbound and westbound Katella
- Reconstructing sidewalks to improve connectivity
- Installing new traffic signals, signage and crosswalk pavement markings



The project, expected to be completed in late 2026, is being supported by OCTA's Public Outreach team, who is leading efforts to inform and engage the community. 
