

UWS 3rd of July Fireworks Spectacular Event Update

Due to ongoing military operations occurring at the Los Alamitos Joint Forces Training Base (JFTB), civilian activities and events on Base have been temporarily paused. Access to the Base has been limited to mission critical personnel only. Unfortunately, this will impact the upcoming UWS 3rd of July Fireworks Spectacular event, resulting in an alternative event format: the fireworks display will take place, and live streamed via the City's social media platforms at 9:00 p.m. on Thursday, July 3, 2025. No public will be allowed on the installation to view the fireworks display.

Construction Activities

Construction is underway and generally occurs on weekdays. Crews are anticipated to perform the following daytime and night time activities listed below.

Night time activities is slated to begin following the Fourth of July holiday to minimize public impacts when lane reductions and ramp closures are required for crews to safely perform the work. These night time activities are expected to continue through the end of July. Check back soon for a list of specific ramp closures.



Daytime Work (6 a.m. to 4 p.m.)

- Install construction signs
- Remove vegetation
- Relocate utilities

Night time Work (9 p.m. to 5 a.m.)

- Install temporary concrete barriers to create a safe work zone
- Restripe Katella Avenue, shifting traffic to the outside lanes.
- Demolish and reconstruct the center median on Katella Avenue/Willow Street beneath the freeway.



Obtaining Parking Permits Just Got Easier!

Beginning June 1, 2025, the City of Los Alamitos is launching a new online parking permitting system:

losalamitos.getapermit.net to improve accessibility and streamline the application process for residents and businesses. Residential parking permit renewals for the 2025–2026 cycle will also begin June 1, with enforcement starting September 1. Each household in a permit zone may request up to three free residential permits and two visitor permits, valid through June 30, 2026. Any additional permits will be subject to a fee. Proof of residency and valid vehicle registration are required.

Permits for oversized vehicles, boats, trailers, RVs, and temporary waste containers will also transition to the new platform starting July 1. For details, visit cityoflosalamitos.org/GetAPermit.




