I-605/Katella Avenue Interchange Construction is Underway

NIGHT TIME CENTER MEDIAN DEMOLITION AND RECONSTRUCTION

WHAT:

Crews are expected to demolish and reconstruct the center median on Katella Avenue/Willow Street beneath the freeway.

The removal of the existing median is anticipated to occur over several nights followed by structural excavation for approximately one week. Night time median reconstruction is expected to continue through the end of July.



Construction activities may require intermittent on- and off-ramp closures or lane reductions on Katella Avenue. Motorists are encouraged to plan ahead.

This work may be loud. The schedule is subject to change due to inclement weather or unforeseen operational issues.

9 p.m. to 5. a.m. nightly, beginning as soon as Wednesday, July 9 and continuing through the end of July.


CLOSURES AND DETOURS MAP

The Orange County Transportation Authority (OCTA), in cooperation with Caltrans, is improving the local interchange at Interstate 605 (I-605) and Katella Avenue. The project will enhance safety and traffic flow by modifying existing on- and off-ramps, making improvements on Katella Avenue, and improving bicycle and pedestrian facilities.


Obtaining Parking Permits Just Got Easier!

Beginning June 1, 2025, the City of Los Alamitos is launching a new online parking permitting system:

losalamitos.getapermit.net to improve accessibility and streamline the application process for residents and businesses. Residential parking permit renewals for the 2025–2026 cycle will also begin June 1, with enforcement starting September 1. Each household in a permit zone may request up to three free residential permits and two visitor permits, valid through June 30, 2026. Any additional permits will be subject to a fee. Proof of residency and valid vehicle registration are required. Permits for oversized vehicles, boats, trailers, RVs, and temporary waste containers will also transition to the new platform starting July 1. For details, visit cityoflosalamitos.org/GetAPermit.


