

I-605/Katella Avenue Interchange Construction is Underway

CENTER MEDIAN RECONSTRUCTION UPDATE

Night time work to reconstruct the center median that is just east of the Coyote Creek channel is expected to continue through the end of August. Crews will continue to perform structural excavation, as well as electrical and concrete activities at the median.

Once the median is reconstructed, crews will be shifting their attention to the sidewalk along westbound Katella Avenue. The sidewalk will be demolished and reconstructed to accommodate improvements along Katella. More information will become available in future communications.

The Orange County Transportation Authority (OCTA), in cooperation with Caltrans, is improving the local interchange at Interstate 605 (I-605) and Katella Avenue. The project will enhance safety and traffic flow by modifying existing on- and off-ramps, making improvements on Katella Avenue, and improving bicycle and pedestrian facilities.





