



I-605/Katella Avenue Interchange Construction is Underway


CONSTRUCTION ON WESTBOUND KATELLA AVENUE PLAN AHEAD FOR DELAYS

WHAT:



Preliminary activities are underway as crews prepare to construct a new bike lane on westbound Katella Avenue. This work includes restriping lanes, saw cutting, placing temporary concrete barriers, and sidewalk demolition.

Sidewalk access on westbound Katella will be closed. Signage is installed to detour pedestrians and bicyclists to use the sidewalk on eastbound Katella.



WHEN:

Work hours are from 6 a.m. to 4 p.m., daily through mid-September. Intermittent night work from 9 pm. to 5 a.m. may be required for certain activities.

CLOSURES:

The outside lane on westbound Katella between Epton Way and the northbound I-605 on-ramp will be closed to create a work zone for crews.

VEGETATION REMOVAL UPDATE

Crews have completed vegetation and tree removal around the northbound and southbound I-605 on- and off-ramps as well as along portions of Katella Avenue. The removal is needed to ensure safe access for upcoming construction activities and accommodate for project improvements

Please plan ahead and expect delays in the area during these times. The following closures are expected to be in place nightly beginning as soon as 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Monday, Aug. 25 through Thursday, Aug. 28 (into Friday morning):

ABOUT THE PROJECT

The Orange County Transportation Authority (OCTA), in cooperation with Caltrans, is improving the local interchange at Interstate 605 (I-605) and Katella Avenue. The project will enhance safety and traffic flow by modifying existing on- and off-ramps, making improvements on Katella Avenue, and improving bicycle and pedestrian facilities.

CYCLIST AND MOTORIST SAFETY REMINDER

During project construction, we encourage drivers and cyclists to use extra caution and stay alert.

- **Drivers:** Slow down in construction zones. Look twice before turning or merging and give cyclists at least three feet of space when passing. Be patient, roadway changes may make it harder for cyclists to navigate.

- **Cyclists:** Follow all posted signs, ride with the flow of traffic, and use hand signals to indicate your intentions. Stay visible by wearing bright clothing and using lights, especially in low-light conditions

H2OC StormwaterProgram

H2OC is a cooperative stormwater program which includes the County of Orange, Orange County Flood Control District (OCFCD), and all 34 cities in Orange County.

Clean beaches and healthy creeks, rivers, bays, and the ocean are important to Orange County. H2OC provides resources to residents and businesses to prevent water pollution and encourages personal action by working with members of each watershed community to prevent polluted runoff from entering our waterways.


