

Park enthusiasts will soon enjoy the newly renovated Labourdette Park with the celebration of a Ribbon Cutting Ceremony on Monday, September 15, at Labourdette Park (4401 Howard Avenue) starting at 3:45 p.m. Immediately following, next on the itinerary will be the Soroptimist Park Groundbreaking Ceremony taking place at Soroptimist Park (10822 Pine Street) beginning at 4:30 p.m. These exciting projects provide the community with an emphasis on improving the quality of life through play and outdoor activities for the whole family. Labourdette Park was funded with a combination of Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) money and General Fund, while Soroptimist Park will be partially paid with Proposition 68 money and General Fund. Soroptimist Park will begin construction this fall through the end of the year 2025.






