

OC San Cypress Trunk Sewer Project

Heads up Los Alamitos—crews and cones are heading to your way! OC San crews have been working in La Palma and Cypress on a regional sewer project and are expected to begin work in Los Alamitos in late November 2025.* Work will start during the day for inspections, followed by nighttime cleaning and grouting of the sewer pipe when flow in the pipes is low. Think of this preparation work as OC San “doing its homework” to prepare for future manhole rehabilitation, ensuring a smooth, efficient process later.




