Basketball Clinics Return for Young Players

Los Alamitos, CA – The City of Los Alamitos Recreation and Community Services Department is excited to announce the return of its youth basketball programs for the upcoming 2025 winter season. This year, families can sign up for Parent & Me Basketball for ages 2–3 and Jr. Pee Wee Basketball for ages 4–6.

These programs will run as five-week, clinic-style sessions at the Oak Middle School Gym, located at 10821 Oak St., Los Alamitos, on Thursdays from January 8 through February 5, 2025, from 5:15 p.m. to 6:00 p.m.

Led by trained Recreation Staff, both programs focus on introducing young athletes to the fundamentals of basketball, including dribbling, passing, shooting, and defense. Sessions include a variety of fun, skill-building drills and games designed to boost motor skills, coordination, and confidence in a supportive and encouraging environment.

Parent participation is required in the Parent & Me Basketball program to help foster a shared experience and provide hands-on support to the youngest participants.

Program fees are \$65 for residents and \$70 for non-residents. Each registration includes a participation award for all players. Registration closes on Wednesday, January 7, 2025, and early registration is encouraged as space is limited.
