**Your Tax Dollars at Work. Los Alamitos in the Trenches – New Dutch Haven  
Neighborhood Street Rehabilitation Project**

LOS ALAMITOS, California – The City of Los Alamitos is preparing to grind and overlay new street pavement as part of the City's ongoing pavement management program. The project will also replace damaged curb & gutter and lifted sidewalk to correct drainage and ADA curb ramps will be modified to current codes as necessary for accessibility. The project includes the following streets located within the New Dutch Haven neighborhood:

- Bennington Street
- Tripoli Avenue
- Howard Avenue
- Mindora Street

The City has awarded the contract for the street improvement project to Hardy and Harper, Inc. The project is scheduled to begin Friday, November 4, 2022 and will take place over a period of approximately 4 weeks. Daily working hours shall be between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. Monday through Friday, except Federal holidays. The majority of the work involving concrete and asphalt repair will be prioritized during the initial weeks with a concentrated effort to reduce impact during the week of Thanksgiving. Additionally, Hardy and Harper, Inc. will make every effort to keep driveways to all residences and businesses open at all times with no interruption to trash hauling and street sweeping services.
